

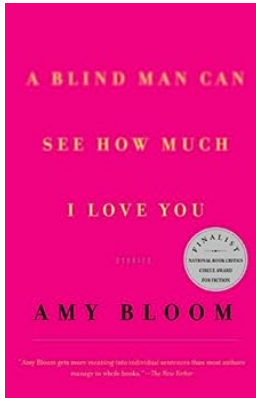
Blind Man Can See How Much Love You

Embracing Technological Advancements

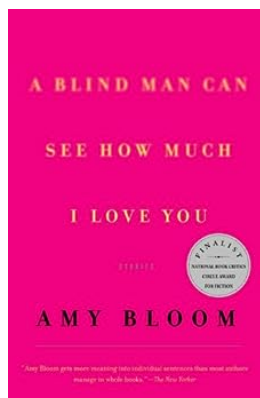
