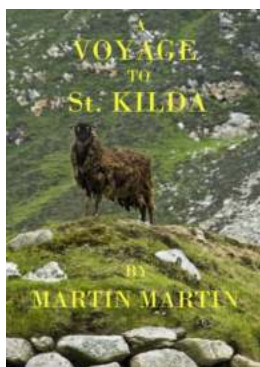

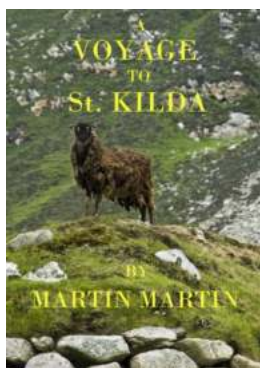

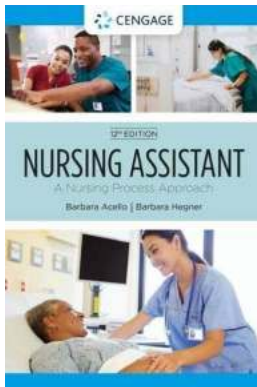

subsequent editions appeared; the fourth in 1753, with the title simply as "A Voyage to St. Kilda".

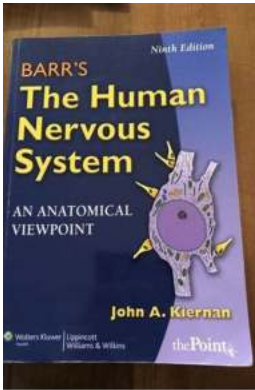

These represent a selection of images used to illustrate his brother Richard's book "With Nature and a Camera", first published in 1897.
