paint, pulled up to reveal another color underneath, as if nature has painted its own mural through texture and ruination.



Examining these details, studying and reflecting on them, in , piecing its story together; that is urban exploration.



Through this book, we will take a journey through the rust belt to see the unseen and find the forgotten.








