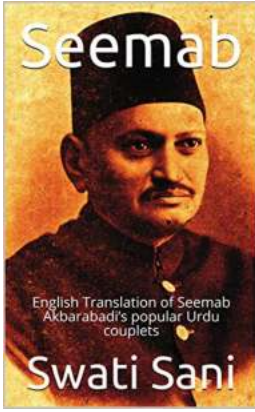

ghazals, Seemab, by now, had also started writing Nazms. He was paying more attention to his nazmiya shayari, as it gave him more scope to present his ideas.

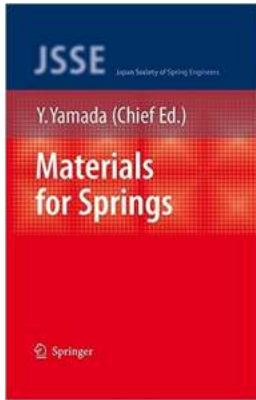

The magazine, Shair, that he started in 1930 is still being published by his grandsons, making it the oldest Urdu literary magazine in publication. One can easily say that Seemab is one of the foremost poets from the pre-modern era of Urdu poetry.



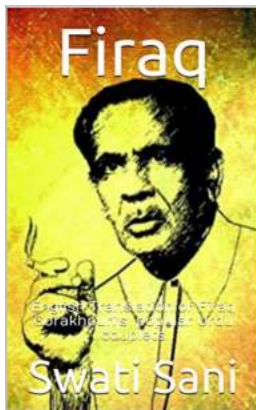

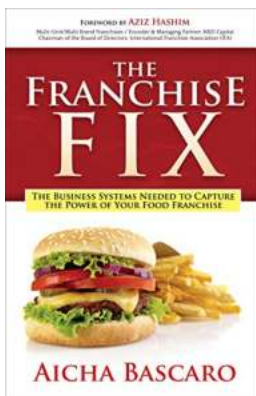

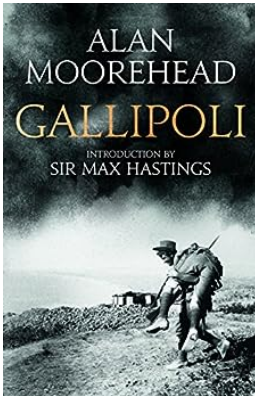
