

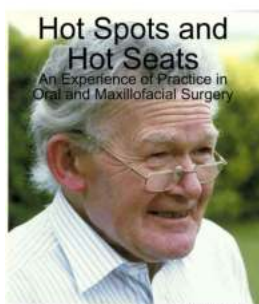

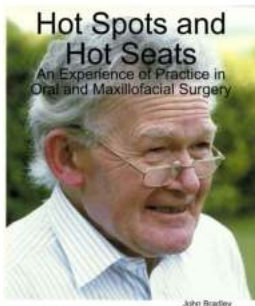

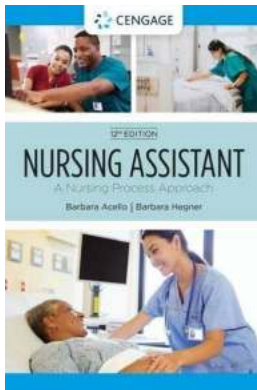

But there is also camaraderie, cooperation, innovation, friendship and humour. John's story is a part of the history of the development of the speciality of Oral

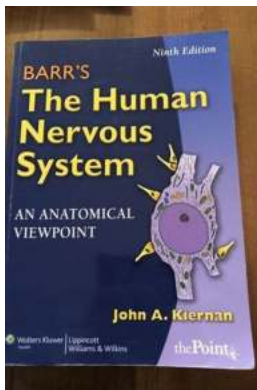

This is a part of how Oral Surgery used to be and how it got to where it is now.



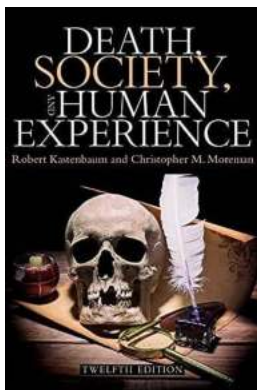
