

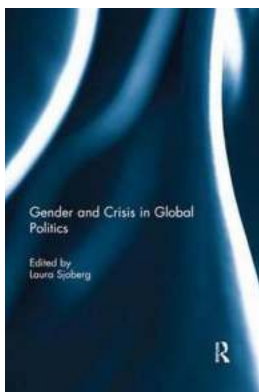

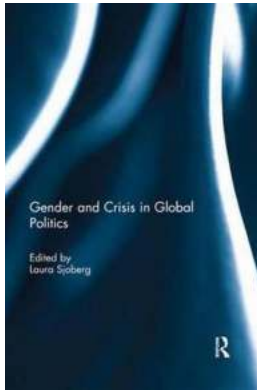

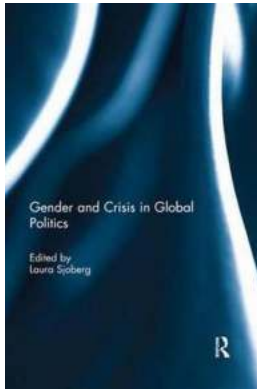

The global political arena is (again) in a time of crisis.
