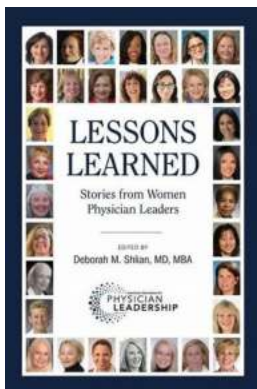

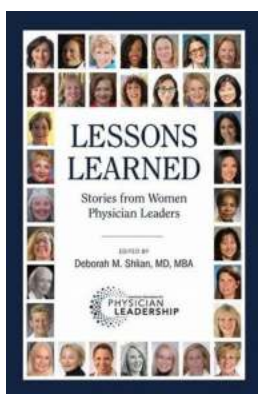

Lessons Learned is a distinctive resource, addressing such topics as:

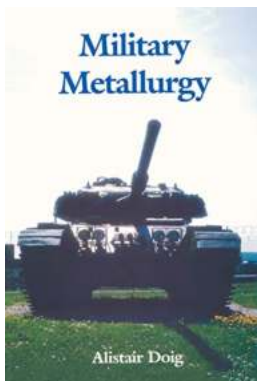
- Career Options after medical training.
