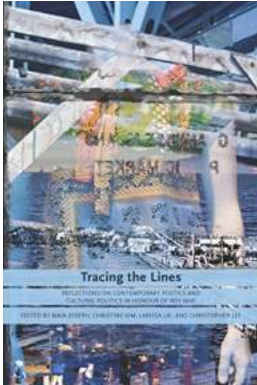

the university to city hall. The collection ends with an interview with Miki on interrelations between his photographic and poetic practices.

Not only did he found the influential literary journal West Coast Line, but he has researched and written works on poets Roy Kiyooka, George Bowering, and bpNichol. Miki taught many of the poets and academics now working and writing on the West Coast.
