CIA officers in Congress often rise through the ranks to become some of the most powerful and well-known Members of Congress. 
Officers of the United States Central Intelligence Agency clearly "hold office under the United States," and they are Constitutionally prohibited from being Members of Congress while they are in the CIA.

Schumer's warning to President-elect Trump in January 2017: "You take on the intelligence community, they have six ways from Sunday at getting back at you."


