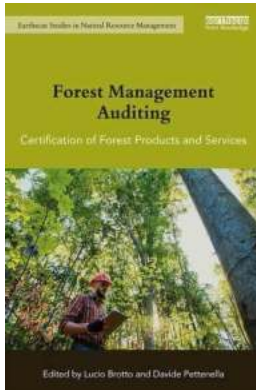
In the autumn of 1996, Joel and Ethan Coen were a few months from filming their seventh feature film, *The Big Lebowski*.
