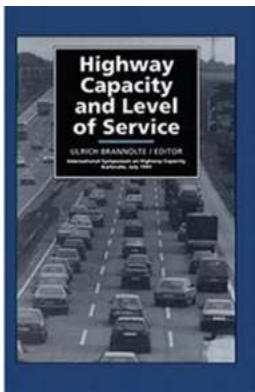

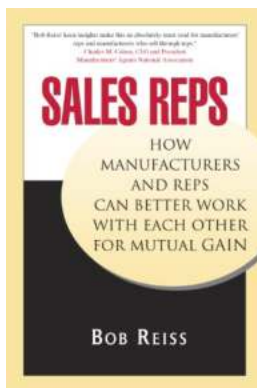
Although Magna Carta failed to resolve the conflict between King John and his barons, it was reissued several times after his death.
