



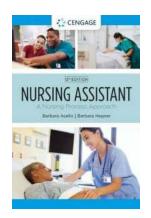
With the creation of cinema at the end of the 19th century, theater did not cease to exist, but the staging of stories in theaters began to share space with the films projected on the big screens.
