Despite this, there were rumours of a potential marriage with Robert Dudley. However, Queen Elizabeth I offered his hand in marriage to the Queen of Scots

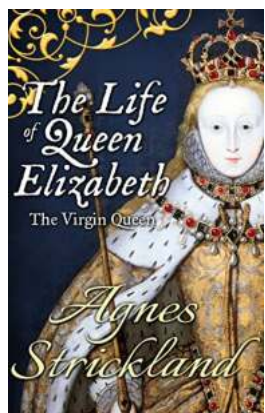
and therefore closed off that avenue. Following this, several suitors are proposed ... of which none came to fruition.
