Cober began his career in the 1960s, when illustration took a turn toward a new expressionism. Cober's aim as a "visual journalist" was to effect change by graphically exposing the realities of our times.

Cober received many awards in his lifetime and was recently inducted into the Society of Illustrators' Hall of Fame.
